SONAR TECHNICIAN

The Job:

Reporting to the Fish and Wildlife Manager and working with the Department of Fisheries and Oceans (DFO) staff on all daily aspects of sonar and camp operations. Test fishing for salmon and other freshwater fish to take measurements and release. Be able to carry out regular camp maintenance such as generators and basic construction. Work within all VGG Occupational Health and Safety best practices.
